

Dress Code

In order to maintain an enjoyable environment for all guests, and in keeping with our business casual dress code, please see the items that are prohibited as part of our dress code:

- Sweat suits or workout attire which includes running/gym shorts, sports bras, hooded sweatshirts or yoga/workout pants
- No exposed undergarments except as noted below:
 - Bustier tops, corset tops, bandeaux tops, and tube tops each may only be worn under a waist length jacket
- Excessively baggy, frayed, or torn clothing.
- Clothing with language or graphics that are vulgar or sexually explicit.
- Men's tank tops, sleeveless t-shirts, or undershirts
- No bandana's worn as head wear
- Footwear is required, however, there are no restrictions on the type of footwear worn
- Hats may only be worn in the bar area and must be worn with the bill facing forward

Please note that exceptions to the dress code policy may be made by management at our discretion.
